



## COOPERATION AGREEMENT

reached on 29th June 2011 in Warsaw, between

called further in the contents of the present document the Institute and

2. **PEDAGOGIUM The College of Social Sciences (WSNS) in Warsaw**, located at Marszałkowska str. 115, 00-102 Warsaw, inscribed in Non-Public Higher Schools Registry and Union Of Non-Public Higher Schools conducted by adequate minister of higher education affairs, after number 365, represented by associate professor reader **Prof. dr hab. Marek Konopczyński – Rector of Pedagogium WSNS in Warsaw**, further called in the contents of the present document the Higher School, or together called the Parts, there was reached the following agreement.

### *PREAMBLE*

Taking into consideration that the Parts, signatories of the present agreement,

1. through scientific research and educational activity firmly contribute to civilisation, social and cultural development of societies for the benefit of which they act,
2. recognize as necessary undertaking common research and development projects in the area of social sciences in order to create a real European integration,
3. respect autonomies and customs of agreeing parts

unanimously decided on what follows.

## § 1

### *[general provisions]*

The purpose of the present agreement is a frame determination of areas, goals and principles of cooperation forms executed by the Parts of the present agreement.

## § 2

### *[cooperation area]*

Cooperation area is covered with scientific disciplines focusing on the analysis of social and educational processes taking place in modern societies, including especially areas of potential exclusions and social pathologies.

## § 3

### *[objectives and extent of cooperation]*

1. The objective of cooperation is:

- a. to increase scientific and organizational potential of agreeing parts;
- b. to exchange scientific, didactic and organizational experience;
- c. to contribute to development of relations of research workers of Czech and Polish nationalities;
- d. cognition of culture, tradition, scientific and civilisation output of both countries;
- e. integration of academic education and practical professional activity.

2. Accomplishment of set objectives will be executed mainly through:

- a. fulfilment of common research projects;
- b. publishing articles in publications and magazines issued by the Parts of the present agreement;
- c. organizing scientific conferences;
- d. organizing scientific internships;
- e. student exchange;
- f. popularizing information on reciprocal cooperation of the Parts with the use of their offices/sections of advertisement and promotion.

§ 4

*[complementary provisions]*

1. In the framework of cooperation development the present agreement can be extended with additional areas of cooperation resultant in gaining experience in reciprocal relations.
2. Offers of common activities can be raised by both parts while spontaneous ideas made by both the workers and the students of both schools will not be excluded.

§ 5

*[development of scientific potential]*

1. The Parts will grant every help needed aiming at gaining by both sides all powers for conferring titles and scientific degrees.
2. The help mentioned in sec. 1 will include accomplishment of common research projects as well as staff support on the side of independent scientific workers.

§ 6

*[common didactic activity]*

The Parts will analyse possibilities of running common master's and doctoral courses by a separated scientific entity working on the areas of agreeing parts.

§ 7

*[financial covenants]*

1. Concluding the agreement does not automatically take effects of financial claims on the side of agreeing Parts.
2. Signing the present agreement does not take effect of taxation results for agreeing Parts.

§ 8

*[operative clause]*

1. The agreement is concluded for indefinite period.

2. Each of the Parts has a right to renounce the agreement with a three-months' notice with legal effect at the end of the month.
3. The agreement can be terminated by the Parts at any time as a result of making a declaration of intent.

§ 9

[*severability clause*]

Invalidity or ineffectuality of any of provisions of the agreement does not contravene validity or effectuality of other provisions. In such case adequate provisions of the law are applied in the place of invalid or ineffective provisions.

§ 10

[*final provisions*]

1. All changes of the present agreement shall be made in writing under clause of nullity.
2. All matters unregulated in the present agreement are subject to adequate provisions of the law valid in the area of the country where the agreement or its part is being executed.
3. The agreement is drew up in two unanimous copies, one for each of the Parts.
4. The agreement comes into effect on the day of subscribing.
